

Consumer Price Index Malaysia February 2018

The overall index for CPI increased by 1.4 per cent in February 2018 to 121.3 compared to 119.6 in corresponding month of the preceding year. The increase in the index was due to higher prices in nine main groups, i.e Food & Non-Alcoholic Beverages (+3.0 per cent), Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance (+2.1 per cent), Health (+2.1 per cent), Housing, Water, Electricity, Gas & Other Fuels (+2.0 per cent), Restaurants and Hotels (+1.8 per cent), Education (+1.1 per cent), Recreation Services & Culture (+0.4 per cent), Miscellaneous Goods & Services (+0.4 per cent) and Alcoholic Beverages & Tobacco (+0.1 per cent).
