#### **INDEX OF INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTION, APRIL 2018**

The Industrial Production Index (IPI) increased by 4.6% in April 2018 as compared with the same month of the previous year. The growth in April 2018 was supported by the increase in all indices: Manufacturing (5.3%), Mining (1.8%) and Electricity (5.8%).

The **Manufacturing** sector output rose by 5.3% in April 2018 after recording a growth of 4.1% in March 2018. The **Mining** sector output recorded an increase of 1.8% in April 2018 compared to the same period of the previous year. The **Electricity** output increased by 5.8% in April 2018 after recording an increase of 4.4% in March 2018. For more info, click HERE. **Source: DOSM**
