ANCHOR CRITERIA	 Ownership - Chosen anchor must manage his/her own business. Experience - Industry related experience - At least 5 years experience and business is still in operation. Turnover - Excellent business track record - Minimum annual turnover of RM 300,000.00 for at least 3 consecutive years (including current year). Legal Actions - Must not have any legal actions against the company / entrepreneur / member of Board of Directors (BOD). Expertise / Training (Optional) - Accredited & registered with NDTS (National Dual Training System) / SLDN (Sistem Latihan Dual Nasional) provider. Certifications (Optional) - Must be certified by ministries/authorities related to the industry.

Part C	Costing breakdown by components covering the activity scope (Development of Fertigation System & Building of RPH, Input Supply & Preparation, Coaching & Monitoring) (Please limit maximum 1 page per workshop)
